COUNCIL BUSINESS:

2019 Goals/Action Workplan Progress: Andrew Hamilton provided an update as to the progress of each of the Council's 2019 Goals. David Mercier went through each goal and objective with Council to determine whether or not the goal had been met for 2019.

2020 Goals/Action Workplan: David Mercier, in going through the 2019 goal results, assisted Council in determining whether or not the previous goals were still appropriate as well as whether or not additions/deletions needed to be made to the individual objectives for each goal for 2020. Each councilmember discussed their priorities for the upcoming year.

DISCUSSION:

All-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance: Councilmember Harvey expressed his desire to see an ordinance enacted similar to one in place by Cowlitz County allowing all-terrain vehicles to drive on City streets. Chief Kirk expressed some safety concerns with specific models of ATV's being on City streets but agreed the ordinance passed by the City of Leavenworth was a good model to use should the Council decide to move forward on this subject.

Sister Cities Program: Mayor Malone provided additional details for an upcoming travel opportunity for Council or Staff who wish to visit sister city Kelso Scotland. Later in the year, members of the Kelso, Scotland Community Council plan to come visit us again as well.
