DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The City of Kelso is undergoing a project to rebuild the outdated Donation Pump Station located on North 4th Avenue. The new wastewater pump station will be built on the footprint of the existing pump station. However, the existing pump station already encroaches into the required front yard setback. Thus, a variance is requested for the new pump station to also encroach into the setback. The project also involves replacing the existing 8-inch force main within 4th Avenue with a 16-inch HDPE force main running south from the pump station approximately 1,150 lineal feet. The site is on North 4th Avenue immediately south of 400 Donation St. The zoning district is Residential Single Family 5,000 square feet (RSF5).
