2 Vice Chair Barbara Stephenson called the meeting to order and roll call was taken.

4 Approve Minutes:

Upon motion by Commissioner Watson, seconded by Commissioner Graves. 'Approve the minutes of the November 15, 2022, Regular Meeting'. Motion passed, all voting yes.

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Public Hearings:

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Croy Street Rezone - LUA2022-0031: The hearing was opened. Mr. Murray summarized the rezone proposal. Originally requested by Kevin Valencia for one parcel to be rezoned from Neighborhood Commercial to Residential Single Family 5000 (RSF-5), after review, staff recommends a rezone for all three lots to RSF-5 since the other two lots are already in residential use. Commissioner Watson made the motion to recommend the rezone to council for approval, seconded by Commissioner Graves. Motion passed, all voting yes. Public hearing closed.

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2022 Unified Development Code Update - LUA2022-0025: The hearing was opened. Mr. Murray summarized the proposal including corrections to confusing language, definitions, mislabeled table columns, changes to accessory dwelling unit requirements, increased lot coverage for RSF-5 zoning, updated requirements for townhouses, removal of conflicting language about the number of lots in a short plat, removal of some of the requirements for a lot consolidation where an internal lot line is being removed, corrections to conflicting language for comment periods so all are now 14 days to comply with state law. Commissioner Watson made the motion to recommend the Unified Development Code Update to council for approval, seconded by Commissioner McCaine. Motion passed, all voting yes. Public hearing closed.

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Downtown Design Review Overlay Removal - LUA2022-0030: The hearing was opened. Mr. Kardas summarized that this change was requested by City Council. Council expressed concerns that the Downtown Design Review Overlay was outdated and had effects on development. Staff prepared the

	language to make the change and upon recommendation from the Planning Commission, will take it
	forward in an ordinance to city council. Commissioner McCaine made the motion to recommend the
	Downtown Design Review Overlay removal to council for approval, seconded by Commissioner Watson
