## **Commission Business:**

The City of Kelso received a request from Larry Wood to vacate a portion of unopened 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The unopened road which is triangular shaped, borders his property on one side, and I-5 right of way on the other. The city will not use the unopened portion of road so the staff requests a recommendation from the Planning

Commission for the vacation to go to City Council for approval.

Mark Chester, of Kelso, asked if it was legal to build duplexes in the zone where the property is located. Mr. Kardas explained that in the Residential Single Family 5000 (RSF-5) zone, duplexes are allowed. Mr. Chester also stated his concern about the infrastructure being able to support 3 new duplexes which would add 6 new homes. Mr. Kardas explained that for single family residences or duplexes, a traffic study is not required because it does not create that dense of a project.

Commissioner Schimmel noted that we are only addressing the vacation for recommendation, not the project.

Monte Kaija, of Kelso, expressed concern about the drop to the freeway where the right of way is located. He believes the vacation should not be granted until a building plan is submitted. He will address his concern at a city council meeting.

Commissioner Stephenson made a motion recommending approval of the Vacation of the Right of Way to City Council. Commissioner Hight seconded the motion. Motion passed, all voting yes.

Planning Commission was asked to recommend to council the adoption of changes to the Shoreline Master Program. Mr. Kardas explained that the update is procedural. The city periodically has to make changes to the Shoreline Master Program. It is funded by state money and they tell us what parts of our program that we have to update. It is a fairly minor update. We are asking Planning Commission to recommend adoption. It will go through a lengthy process with public hearings at city council. He explained that the changes that the state asked the city to make are in the document that the commissioners received.
