KELSO-LONGVIEW ROTARY INVESTMENTS IMPROVE SAFETY, SECURITY AT CATLIN SPRAY PARK

KELSO, WASHINGTON, AUGUST 1, 2017 –

Kelso's Catlin Rotary Spray Park received an outpouring of support from three local Rotary Clubs that donated over \$21,000 in money, labor and materials for safety and security improvements. The Kelso, Longview, and Longview – Early Edition Rotary Clubs purchased and installed new decorative lighting around the perimeter of the spray pad, resurfaced the spray area with slip-resistant paint, and restored landscaping near the senior center. The improvements provide lighting for enhanced security, a spray pad less prone to trips and falls, and a better overall park appearance.
